United Cable Industries Company (hereinafter referred to as "UCIC" or the "Company") is a public shareholding company established in Jordan to manufacture power cables and wires. The Company's headquarters are based in Amman, and the factory is located in Al Mafraq Governorate - Taghrat Al-Jab. On March 13,2025 UCIC's Board of Directors approved the distribution of 4.0% of its paid-up capital in cash dividends to its shareholders.

Recommendation Summary

UFICO's **BUY** recommendation on UCIC is the result of our systematic analysis of four basic characteristics mentioned above. The Company demonstrates strong earnings momentum and solid financial stability, supported by prudent management. Its current market price appears undervalued relative to fundamentals, and technical indicators continue to support a positive outlook, making it an attractive investment opportunity at this level.

Major Risks & Rewards

- > Operational Risks: Supply chain disruptions, regulatory changes, or operational inefficiencies could all have an impact on UCIC's operations. While UCIC's diversified market presence offers some protection, the indirect effects of increased raw material costs due to supply chain disruptions (i.e Red Sea conflict) challenges remain a concern.
- > Credit and Collection Risk: Customer payment delays or defaults might have an impact on UCIC's cash flow and liquidity. Effective credit management and strict collection strategies are required to reduce this risk.
- > Raw Material Price Volatility: Price fluctuations in key raw materials used in cable manufacture, such as copper and aluminium, can have an impact on production costs and margins. Effective cost management and sourcing techniques are required to reduce this risk.
- > Financial Stability: The decreasing debt/assets and debt/equity ratios, and stronger current ratio indicate UCIC's financial stability, which appeals to risk-averse investors.
- > Earnings Growth: Strong earnings growth, with net income rising significantly in Q1 2025, indicates operational efficiency and profitability.
- > Dividend Distribution: UCIC distributed JOD 0.040/ Share in cash dividends for 2024, reflecting its ongoing commitment to shareholders.

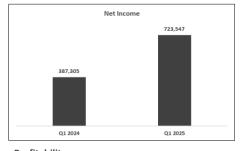
- P/E vs. Industry: is below the peers average and the median indicating potential undervaluation.

- Dividend Payout Ratio of 48.4%, indicating payments are well covered by earnings.

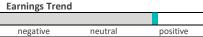

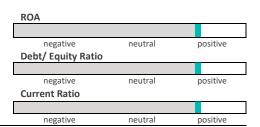

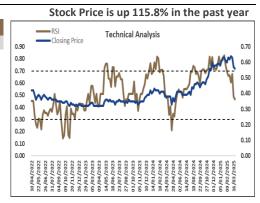
- Return on Assets; moderate and marks an improvement compared to Q1 2024.

- Price Volatility indicates a high level of fluctuation in price over time. The higher the volatility, the riskier the stock.
- 14-Day Relative Strength Index (RSI) indicates the stock has reached overbought territory, suggesting a potential for a short-term price correction. Traditionally, a stock is considered overbought or overvalued when RSI is above 70 and oversold or undervalued when it is below 30.
- Moving Averages (MA): The stock currently trades above its 200-day MA, suggesting a potential Buy signal. The MA for the 50-day MA at 0.62 and the 100day MA at 0.64 indicates a Buy signal based on the stock's current price levels.
- Average Volume (3 Months) indicates moderate trading activity, and an acceptable level of market participation.



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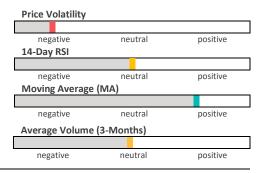
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Price movement is an evaluation based on a company's relative share price strength in the past 1-quarter, 14 day and 1-year period. **UCIC** had a positive price strength in the past 200-day period indicating a favourable signal of near-term price gain.

UCIC is currently showing strong bullish momentum, holding well above its 200-day MA. The stock just reached a 52-week high of JD 0.84, indicating continued buying demand and investor confidence. If momentum continues, the next goal might be around the psychological resistance of JD 0.90, with support levels between JD 0.75 and JD 0.70 offering potential entry chances on any downturn.



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UFICO Stock Ratings: UFICO's coverage of stocks uses a quantitative model that evaluates a company's relative valuation, earnings strength, financial stability, and its recent price movement. UFICO's five recommendation ratings include strong buy, buy, hold, sell, strong sell. For all stocks in our coverage universe, ratings are generated each week and reflect the fundamental and price data as of the last trading day of the week.

Relative Valuation: Relative valuation is a weighted combination of factors that measure a company's current stock price valuation vs industry. These include the company's price-to-earnings vs. industry, and its price-to-book vs. industry. UFICO also measures the rank of a company's dividend yield among dividend payers on the Amman Stock Exchange. A stock may stay undervalued or overvalued for a long period of time. For this reason, it is important to combine dividend yield rank factor with shorter-term predictive factors such as earnings momentum or price momentum to identify more imminent valuation adjustments. In addition, UIFCO also measure a company's dividend payments growth over the past 10 years and the degree its dividend payments are covered by earnings.

Earnings Strength: Over 20 years of research have shown that the change in the growth of earnings per share is an important factor that drives stock price performance. UFICO measures earnings momentum to get an early indication of changing earnings patterns. Earnings strength is a weighted combination of factors that measure a company's earnings growth performance. These include the company's 5-year average earnings growth rate, its 1-year earnings growth rate vs its 5-year average earnings growth rate, its 1-year earnings growth rate vs. industry, its relative strength of ROE, and its y-o-y profit margin growth rate.

Financial Stability: Financial stability is a weighted combination of factors that measure a company's ability to pay its debts in the short and long terms. UFICO looks for a company's capital structure where its total liabilities do not exceed 40% of its equity. For a company's solvency strength, we look for an interest coverage of at least 3x, indicating a company's ability to cover its interest payments through its operating income, and a debt coverage of at least 200%, indicating a company's ability to cover its loans and interest payments through its operating income. For liquidity strength, we look for a company's current ratio of at least 1.25x, indicating current liabilities are sufficiently covered by current assets. Companies in the banking sector are analyzed using assets/equity ratio, loans/deposits ratio, loans/assets ratio, and level of bad loans. For assets/equity ratio, we look for a ratio below 10x, indicating adequate reliance on debt to fund the bank's operations. For loans/deposits ratio, we look for a ratio below 125%, indicating high liquidity and low exposure risk to cover unexpected funding requirements. For loans/asset ratio, we look for a ratio below 110%, indicating high liquidity and low exposure risk to defaults. For the level of bad loans, we look for a ratio below 5.00%, indicating lower provisions are required and, hence, increases bank profitability.

Recent Price Movement: Historical price action of a company's stock is an especially helpful measure used to identify intermediate and short term performance potential. Long term historical performance is a good predictor of future price performance, but much more importantly, large price movements over the intermediate and short term tend to reverse themselves. UFICO's price momentum measure integrates historical long, intermediate and short term price changes, creating ratings that are highest for stocks with strong twelve-month price performance that have had a price consolidation in the past quarter and month. Price movement is an evaluation based on a company's relative share price strength in the past 1-quarter, 14-day and 1-year period. In UFICO's analysis, positive price strength in the past 200-day period is a favorable indication of near-term price gain. Conversely, positive price changes in the past quarter or 14-day period can indicate a short-term overbought condition resulting in negative near-term price change.

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
